- When submitting a ticket, the user should get a receipt via e-mail
- It should be explained that it is a system, not a person receiving the e-mail when submitting a mail to <u>epim.drilling@posccaesar.org</u> or <u>epim.production@posccaesar.org</u>
- The sites should clearly show that this is EPIM and not POSC Caesar. EPIM's logo should be used together with the statement "Hosted by PCA"
- EPIM RUF should only advice on how to implement standards in cases where other organizations don't have any rules or regulations applying to standard implementations.
- The prevailing version of the standards should be available and stored at epim.no
- Only Line Eltervaag and a POSC Caesar administrator should have access to upload files to the file repository
- Example data sets should be available in the file repository
